

RULES FOR THE CONTEST

- 1) Participants should send their camera ready paper in IEEE (PDF) format (IEEE format may be downloaded from our website for reference). This paper should reach AISAT on or before 10th February 2012 via e-mail (academics@aisat.ac.in).
- 2) Paper should not exceed 5 pages.
- 3) Acknowledgement of the receipt of the entries would be sent by 11th February through email.
- 4) Along with the camera ready paper, each participant should furnish their details in the format given in the brochure.
- 5) Ten papers will be shortlisted by expert Committee and another five papers will be waitlisted. Shortlisted and waitlisted candidates will be intimated via e-mail latest by 16th February 2012.
- 6) Shortlisted and waitlisted candidates shall download application form for AVANZA-'12 from the college website (www.aisat.ac.in). Application duly signed by HOD should be submitted at registration counter at AISAT on 24th February 2012.
- 7) All the participants are required to bring three hard copies of their paper along with them on the day of the event.
- 8) The presentations and hard copy of papers will be collected from the participants during registration (Please check the schedule on the website). Presentations should only be in ppt format.
- 9) All the participants (short listed and waitlisted) present during the event will be given a participation certificate.
- 10) Short listed candidates are entitled to present their paper during the event.
- 11) In case if any of the short listed candidates does not turn up, the wait listed candidates will be given the opportunity for presentation. However the waitlisted candidates should come prepared for presentation.
- 12) Selected candidates will be provided with a) PC b) Microsoft Office 2010 and c) LCD Projector for presentation.

PRESENTATION

- 1) Each participant must formally present his or her paper on the day of the event. Presentation must be of 15 minutes' duration.
- 2) If the paper is prepared by multiple authors (maximum 3), only the first author will be allowed to present the paper.
- 3) A 5-minutes interaction session will follow the presentation.
- 4) Presentations may be accompanied by visual aids.

JUDGING CRITERIA

The expert committee will evaluate the presentations for their originality, content, and impact created by the contestant and their decision will be final.

ELIGIBILITY

Students of any branch of Engineering from AICTE approved Engineering Colleges in Kerala are eligible to participate in the programme.
